

**Lagutskottets betänkande****1975/76: 1****med anledning av propositionen 1975/76: 21 med förslag till lag om ändring i jordabalken****Propositionen**

I propositionen 1975/76: 21 föreslår regeringen (justitiedepartementet) riksdagen att anta ett förslag till lag om ändring i jordabalken.

Lagförslaget innebär att möjligheterna att få till stånd s. k. lagfarts-sammanträde vidgas. Enligt förslaget skall sådant sammanträde kunna hållas, om den som påstår sig ha förvärvat fast egendom inte kan förete sin fångeshandling eller denna är bristfällig. Vidare föreslås vissa förenklingar i förfarandet vid anteckning om innehav av pantbrev och vilandebevis samt vid dödning av inskrivning.

Lagändringarna föreslås träda i kraft den 1 januari 1976.
