

Utrikesutskottets betänkande

1981/82:2

om dokumenten rörande baltutlämningen

Motionen

I motion 1980/81:912 av Anders Björck m. fl. (m) hemställs att riksdagen i skrivelse till regeringen ger till känna att de dokument avseende den s. k. baltutlämningen, som ej kan skada enskild person, befrias från hemligstämpel samt att de viktigaste dokumenten av regeringen publiceras i form av en vitbok.

Utskottet

Dokumentet avseende utlämningen till Sovjetunionen av de balter som i samband med den tyska kapitulationen våren 1945 internerades i Sverige blir enligt gällande sekretesslag tillgängliga för allmänheten efter 40 år, dvs. år 1985, möjligen med undantag av uppgifter som kan skada enskild person. De centrala dokumenten har emellertid redan gjorts tillgängliga för två svenska forskare, som gjort framställning härom.

Utskottet finner därför att forskningsintresset för denna händelse på ett rimligt sätt blivit tillgodsett. Något angeläget behov av att före år 1985 göra dokumenten allmänt tillgängliga – med avsteg från sekretesslagens bestämmelse om uppgifter som angår Sveriges förbindelser med annan stat – anser utskottet inte föreligga. Ett eventuellt initiativ till publicering av en s. k. vitbok, nu eller i samband med frisläppandet år 1985, torde i första hand ankomma på regeringen.

Mot denna bakgrund avstyrker utskottet ifrågavarande motion.

Utskottet hemställer

att riksdagen avslår motion 1980/81:912.
